

Blackall100, Blackall50 and Blackall21 Event Cancellation Policy

Cancellation or Rescheduling of Event

Circumstances may arise that mean changes have to be made to the Event e.g. COVID-19 restrictions, fire, extreme weather conditions. Run Queensland will make every effort to ensure the amended Event goes ahead safely. Refunds will not be made available for participants in this instance.

If the Event cannot be held on the set date, Run Queensland may either reschedule or cancel it. If this happens, these three options will be made available to participants:

- transfer their entry to the new date,
- receive a credit towards next year's event,
- receive a refund less administration and running cost fee.

Refunds due to COVID-19

Participants who cannot attend the Event due to COVID-19 border closures or lockdowns will have the following two options:

- receive a credit towards next year's event,
- receive a refund less administration and running cost fee.

Participants will need to provide relevant details and proof of their residential address before any refund or credit are given.

The same two options are available to participants who are required to self-isolate due to COVID-19 and cannot make the Event. Please note you will need to provide relevant details, which may include a dated COVID test, before any refund or credit are given.
